Linda Alterwitz (American, b. 1960): Seeing, and not seeing, is my passion and vocation. I am an independent interdisciplinary artist with a focus on photography. Early in my development as a photographer, through a personal health crisis, I became fascinated by the high-tech imaging used in medical treatment. Although my work originated from a place of resilience, twenty years later, it has evolved into visualizing unseen systems that shape our world, encouraging dialogue around choice, trust, and collective experience.

Between 2021 and 2023, I developed *Injection Site*, a series of thermal photographs showing the inflammation response to the Covid19 vaccine in the arms of 130 participants. Each photograph, registering the heat of inflammation underneath the skin, showed a unique response to the vaccine for each person. This work led to the following selected grants, awards, and exhibitions:

- The Ulrich Art Museum: invited for solo exhibition at Wichita State University, KS (2026).
- **MW Editions**: selected for publication as a monograph with an accompanying text by Leah Ollman (2026).
- **Nevada Arts Council Visual Arts Fellow**: selected for the second time for *Injection Site* (2025).
- **FORMAT International Photography Festival**: selected for exhibition and delivery of conference paper at University of Derby, Derby, UK (2025).
- **New York Times**: selected by the Eslah Attar, NYT Image Editor, to accompany an article by Immunologist, Dr Rick Bright (2024).
- Claremont McKenna College: invited to give a keynote address on *Injection Site*, Claremont, CA (2023).
- Lilley Museum of Art: invited for a solo exhibition at University of Nevada, Reno (2023).
